



## **Service Updates - Commencing Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2020**

CT4N are making further changes to timetables from Monday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2020. The majority of these changes were due to come in to effect from April 2020, however they were suspended due to the lockdown of the UK, therefore these changes are being made to reflect current travel patterns.

### **Service S11**

Additional journey for enhanced social distancing measures will depart towards Christ the King Academy at 08:10 from Oxclose Lane Police Station, with an additional journey in the afternoon towards Top Valley departing from Christ the King Academy at 15:27

### **Service L2**

Timetable revised throughout the day with additional journeys at morning and afternoon peak to serve Glaisdale Parkway, Bilborough College & Nottingham Business Park. All journeys will operate via Trowell Road, with journeys no longer serving Beechdale Estates during the day.

### **Service L4**

Revised timetable throughout the day, with journeys extending past Strelley ASDA to serve Beechdale Estate.

### **Service L5**

The final journey of the day from the City will now depart at 15:15, however later journeys via Middleton Boulevard are available by catching service L2. All journeys will serve Castle Marina Park.

### **Services L10, L11, L12**

Revised timetables throughout the day on most journeys operating on these services.

On service L11, an additional journey will commence from Bagnall Road at 08:00 towards Bilborough (Bracebridge Drive Shops) to provide additional social distancing measures for school children travelling.

### **Service L14**

Revised timetable throughout the day, with journeys to Bulwell now terminating at Bulwell Bus Station. Journeys to Norwich Gardens & Morrisons are available via shopper service S11, which operates hourly throughout the day.

### **Service W1**

Revised timetable in the morning and afternoon journeys will no longer serve the City Loop.

### **Medilink**

Additional bus will depart from Wilkinson Street towards Queens Medical Centre at 06:30 to provide social distancing measures
